- Due to high demand, we're unable to accommodate siblings of SKD students who don't attend our school.
- Ages: From Pre-K 3 graduates to 3rd graduates.

Bathroom Independence Matters

For the comfort of all campers, please ensure your child is 100% toilet trained, independent in the bathroom, and can tell an adult when they need to go. In cases of continuous accidents, we will kindly ask for you to make alternative arrangements this summer.

Stay Connected - Because We Care!

Communication is key, and we've got you covered:

- **ClassDojo App:** Join before camp starts to stay in the loop individually and as a group.
- **Timing Matters:** Messages after 5:00 pm? We'll catch up with you after 7:00 am the next day. Weekend Messages? We'll be back on Monday after 7:00 am.

Drop-Off/Pick-Up with a Smile!

- Morning Drop-Off: Drop-off from 9:00 am to 9:15 am at the Pre-K building.
- **Guided Entry:** Parents drop off campers at the bottom of St. Francis's Center Ramp, with our Jr. Counselors and Camp Buddies making sure everyone's accounted for.
- Afternoon Pick-Up: Camp concludes at 3:00 pm. Our counselors will escort each group down the ramp and release the kids to their beaming parents.

CARES: Drop-Off/Pick

- **Drop-off:** Ring the bell at the Pre-K 4 building for a warm welcome from our counselors.
- **Pick-up:** Another ring, and your child is ready to join you.

Arrival or Absence Hints

• **Stay Connected:** Use ClassDojo to communicate a late arrival or absence.

When Health Matters - Our Wellness Policy

• **Illness Update:** If your child is sent home sick or absent due to illness, a fever-free 24 hours post-medication is our golden rule.

Dress for Fun - Let's Splash!

- Attire: Campers come in bathing suits (girls under play clothes), socks, and sneakers. <u>No</u> <u>flipflops, please.</u>
- Waterplay Ready: Towel and water shoes for the splashiest moments.

What to Bring - Essentials for a Camp Adventure

- **Daily Essentials:** Backpack, towel, sunscreen, a change of clothes, water bottle, and morning snack.
- Full-Day Extras: Lunch for full-day campers.
- **CARES Snack:** Don't forget a separate snack for before or after CARES.
- Label Love: Label everything with your child's name let's keep it all in the family!

• **Daily Shield:** Apply sunscreen before camp; we'll reapply before waterplay. Sharing is caring, but only if they're siblings!

Behave the Sunny Way - Our Expectations

- **Dismissal Policy:** Children who fail to follow camp rules and behave respectfully will be dismissed from the program.
